

M11.- MANU RESERVED ZONE NATURAL PARADISE 5 DÍAS / 4 NOCHES (BUS/ FLIGHT)

**CUSCO –PAUCARTAMBO -BOSQUE DE NUVES-PILLCOPATA-ATALAYA-OTORONGO-SALVADOR
–BOCA – COLRADO PEM -CUSCO**

This 5-day adventure begins in Cusco, from here we enter the jungle to enjoy the unique landscape of the Manu National Park, from the first moment we observe species such as the rooster of the rocks and the trogons, navigating then the Madre de Dios River. more bird species such as the jungle condor; We make a stop in Aguas Calientes to take a medicinal bath. We continue to the community of Diamante to carry out experiential tourism.

We entered the Reserved Zone, continued the trip by boat and observed magnificent animals such as the white crocodile, turtles and capybaras. After arriving to Cocha Salvador and aboard a catamaran, we can observe the river otters and more birds. We will also go to see the spectacle of the macaw's tail.

DAY 01: CUSCO - CLOUD FOREST - PILCOPATA.- We start from Cusco very early in the morning Time: 5:30 - 6:00 a.m. I pick up from the hotel on our comfortable bus. On the way we visit the funerary towers or Chullpas de Ninamarca at 3750 masl and brief visit to Paucartambo folklore town, colonial bridge. We ascend to the upper area of Paucartambo. Acjanaco is the highest point at 4000 meters above sea level. Then we descend through the mysterious cloud forest, which houses a wide variety of flora and fauna full of beautiful orchids, heliconias and primitive ferns. We made a walk to appreciate the Cock of the Rocks (*Rupicola peruviana*) in the mating ritual. There is also the possibility of observing Trogones (*Trogon* sp.), Quetzals, monkeys and the only bear of South America, the spectacled bear (*Tremarctos ornatus*). In the afternoon we will arrive at our HOSTEL, in Pilcopata (550 m.n.m.) in our typical hostel in the area with hot water in the showers and private bathroom.

DAY 02: PILCOPATA–ATALAYA- BOCA MANU - OTORONGO After the delicious breakfast we continue our journey 45 minutes by bus to watchtower port on the way we see coca and fruit trees plantations and orchids, we embark on motorized boat by the Madre de Dios river, on the way we can see a variety of birds, such as herons, kingfisher and always the presence of vultures of which the most spectacular is the condor of the jungle, the king of the vultures (*Sarcoramphus papa*) and the Jaguar (*Panthera Onca*) we have a stop in Boca Manu (280 masl) and then brief stop at the guardaparquez control (LIMAL SURVEILLANCE POSITION). The boat trip continues and one begins to realize why Manu is so famous for its wildlife. On the banks of the river there are groups of turtles, white alligators (*Cayman cocodrylus*) or perhaps some ronsocos (*Hydrochoerus*, *hydrochaeris*) and many more. In the afternoon we arrive to our safari camp in Cocha Otorongo (250 masl) (double beds inside platforms) shortly after we organize a walk to visit the lake and the observation tower of 30 meters from where we have the opportunity to observe the river wolves, turtles and birds. Here in the Manu the animals have never suffered hunting persecution by men. Night in safari camp on platforms with roof double beds with mosquito net. Showers and shared bathrooms.

DAY 03: COCHA OTORONGO - COCHA SALVADOR - RESERVED AREA- The group visits Cocha Salvador today which is 30 minutes away from Cocha Otorongo. Today they explore walking in the virgin primary forest, We visit the lake to paddle silently in a catamaran that gives us the possibility to observe the wolves of the river again and a great variety of strange birds, the sultana cock (*Porphyrula Martinica* or the Garga Agami (*Agamia*) and monkeys of different species are almost certainly observed 9 species.We later walk on the main trails with the guide to learn the operation and secrets of the tropical forest.In the afternoon we return to our camp in Cocha Otorongo. on platforms with a roof Beds with mosquito net Shared showers and baths available Optional night walk.

DAY 04: COCHA OTORONGO - RESERVED AREA - BOCA MANU - PUERTO MALDONADO-

Very early in the morning, the group will continue its trip along the Manu river with an approximate of 7 hours and then we will take the bus with an approximate 4 hours return to Puerto Maldonado in the short trip to Cocha Brasco to observe giant otters.

DAY 05.- PUERTO MALDONADO – CUSCO Return to Cusco, depending on the time of flight. They usually arrive in Cusco at 1pm.
